

Key Amendments for TADP 2024

TADP Section	2024 Change (in mark-up)	Rationale
10.14.3	Where an Event that will or may take place after the period of Ineligibility has an entry deadline that falls during the period of Ineligibility, the Player may submit an application for entry in the Event in accordance with that deadline, notwithstanding that at the time of such application they are still Ineligible.	Addition to clarify that the absence of a precise date as to when a Provisional Suspension will end does not alter a Player's ability to register for Events where they anticipate they will be eligible at the time of the Event (noting registration dates are multiple weeks before an Event). Where it transpires that a Provisional Suspension is not lifted by the draw date, Governing Bodies withdraw the Player in accordance with their own processes. This is in line with the intention of the rule (and in line with other WADA-compliant sports) not to prevent a Player from playing for longer than any period of Ineligibility (provisional or otherwise).
10.13.2.1	Any period of Provisional Suspension (whether imposed or voluntarily accepted) that has been respected by the Player or other Person will be credited against the total period of Ineligibility to be served. If a period of Ineligibility is served pursuant to a decision that is subsequently appealed, then the Player or other Person shall receive a credit for such period of Ineligibility served against any period of Ineligibility which may ultimately be imposed on appeal.	Additional wording is mandatory WADA wording which was unintentionally omitted in the drafting of the previous TADP.
